Nabokov began his third novel in February 1929. "I began writing it…at Le Boulou—a small spa in the Pyrenees Orientales where I was hunting butterflies—and finished it the same year in Berlin. I remember with special limpidity a sloping slab of rock, in the ulex- and ilex-clad hills, where the main thematic idea of the book first came to me", he wrote in his foreword to the English language translation. That completion date was in August (*VNTRY* 275–76, 289–90, 291 and *VB* 59–61).

Защита Лужина was serialized in Современные записки [Sovremennye zapiski/Contemporary annals], Paris. Chapters 1–4 were in No. XL (Nov-1929), pp. 163–210; chapters 5–9 in No. XLI (Jan-1930), pp. 99–164; and, chapters 10–14 in No. XLII (Apr-1930), pp. 127–210. It was excerpted in Руль [Rul'/The rudder], Berlin, 15-Sep-1929 and 12-Jan-1930 and in Последние новости [Poslednie novosti/The latest News], Paris, 6-Apr-1930. The book was published in Berlin by Slovo in September 1930 in, as Nabokov wrote in the foreword to the English language edition, "...[a] paperbound edition, 234 pp., 21 by 14 cm., jacket a solid dull black with gilt lettering..."

Michael Scammel's translation into English was completed by October 1962. Nabokov corrected it in the latter part of 1963 and wrote the foreword on 15-Dec-1963. On 15-Jan-1964, *The New Yorker* made an offer for the novel. It appeared in two issues (9-May and 16-May-1964), the first time the magazine had ever published a complete novel. There were, however, many textual differences between how it appeared in the magazine and how it appeared here in book form (*VNTAY* 470, 472, 475, 476, 481, 485, 725 and *VB* 62–3). McGraw-Hill released the book on 24-Sep-1964.

The books were given to visitors from the Soviet Union. The program was covertly funded at that time by the C.I.A. (Ludmilla Thorne in a letter to *The New Yorker*, 21-Nov-2005, p. 10.)

At the end of 1965 Radio Liberty, which beamed programs into the Soviet Union, offered to publish Nabokov works for clandestine distribution in


the U.S.S.R. under the imprint of Editions Victor. *Priglashenie na kazn'* preceded this edition a year earlier. (*VNTAY* 504-5, 524.)
